Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport is the primary international airport serving Atlanta, Georgia, United States. Named after former Atlanta mayors William B. Hartsfield and Maynard Jackson, it was the world's busiest airport by passenger traffic from 1998 to 2019.
